Today, on 06 Jeth Nankshahi Sammat 539 (20 May 2007), at Sri Akal Takht Sahib the Five Jathedars met and passed the following Gurmatte

1. Today, on 06 Jeth Nanakshahi Sammat 539 (20 May 2007), the Dera Sirsa published posters containing very clever wording in the newspapers which are hereby discarded.
2. Dera Sirsa Chief Gurmeet Ram Rahim Singh tried to imitate Sikh initiation process (baptism) at Salabatpur Dera and on May 13, 2007 Sikhs protesting against posters related to this published in newspapers were beaten brutally. Therefore, people of all religions are called for 'Punjab Bandh' on 08 Jeth Nanakshahi 539 (22 May 2007) in protest for hurting Sikh sentiments. During Punjab Bandh, it is advised not to indulge in any sort of violent activity and maintain peace and order. On 17 Jeth Nankshahi 539 (31 May 2007), a 'Ros March' will start from Gurudwara Fatehgarh Sahib at 10:00 am in the morning to handover 'Yaad pattar' (letter) to Punjab/Haryana governor.
3. Gurmeet Ram Rahim should close Dera Salabatpur and other Deras across Punjab till 13 Jeth Nanakshahi 539 (27 May 2007) otherwise next serious step would be taken on 17 Jeth Nanakshahi sammat 539 (31 May 2007).
4. To put to end all the anti-Sikh activities of Gurmeet Ram Rahim, a committee from Sri Akal Takht Sahib will take steps to speed up CBI inquiry against cases of murder, rapes and other anti-social activities against him and meet President, Prime Minister and other concerned authorities to get it completed before 16 Jeth Nanakshahi Sammat 539 (30 May 2007).
